### INTEGRATED PROGRAMMES WITH SPANISH STUDENTS (PI)

Each programme consists of regular degree courses taken alongside Spanish students (see programme designations below).

- Minimum level of Spanish (B2) required to take classes taught in Spanish. A pre-admission placement test from the Universidad Nebrija is available.
- If a student wishes to take classes taught in English, the home university should make sure the student has a minimum level of B2 in English.
- Students will choose courses from only one programme, which will take place entirely on one campus (Madrid-Princesa, La Berzosa, Dehesa de la Villa Campus, depending on the area of study).

In accordance with the provisions of the General Data Protection Regulations, it is stated that the data provided will be processed by UNIVERSITAS NEBRISSENSIS, S.A. (hereinafter, NEBRIJA UNIVERSITY), with offices in Hoyo de Manzanares, Campus de la Berzosa, 28240- Madrid, telephone number 914521101 and email lopd@nebrija.es. You can contact our Data Protection Delegate at the email address DPO@nebrija.es.

The personal data will be processed in order to prepare the applications for admission and respond to them, as well as, where appropriate, to process the enrollment into the requested program, provide the educational services corresponding to said program and manage any activity associated with it. The processing of the data is necessary for the correct management of the programs offered by NEBRIJA UNIVERSITY and requested by the interested party, this service provision being the basis of said treatment, for which it is mandatory that personal data be provided, given that registration in the corresponding program is not possible otherwise.

In the event that information on the accommodation offered by this university is requested, your data will be processed to send you the information, and may be communicated, in this case, to Nebrija Residences (in the case of request for information on Residences and Residence Hall) or to Nebrija Institutes (in the case of information on other accommodations). In this case, the basis of the treatment is your consent, expressed when requesting information about the accommodation, not being required to provide your data for this purpose, in which case, you cannot be recipient of said information. You can withdraw the consent at any time, although this will not affect the lawfulness of the treatments carried out previously. In the event that you reserve the accommodation, your data will be treated on the basis of the contractual relationship maintained and for the purpose of managing it and communicated to the person or entity in charge of the accommodation (families or Nebrija residences). In this case, it is mandatory that personal data is provided, given that the management of the accommodation is not possible otherwise.

Similarly, if the student requests the Intensive Preparatory Spanish Language Course, his/her data will be transferred to Nebrija Institutes, the entity in charge of teaching the course. For this purpose, their data will be treated on the basis of the contractual relationship maintained and with the purpose of offering said course. In this case, it is mandatory that personal data is provided, given that the management of the corresponding course is not possible otherwise.

Unless this box is checked \(\sigma\), the data may be used to send information, by electronic means, of the services, offers and events carried out by the university. The basis of this treatment is the existence of a legal relationship that allows, according to what is reflected in article 21.2 of the Law on Services of the Information Society and Electronic Commerce, to treat the data for commercial purposes without the need for an application or prior authorization of the student.

The data will be kept until the end of the registration process and, if admitted, until the end of the program or the service offered and, even later, until the possible responsibilities that may arise from it and throughout the time required by the applicable regulations. Notwithstanding the above, your data may be kept indefinitely for the purpose of sending commercial communications, unless you object to them as indicated in the previous paragraph or in each communication that is sent.

The data may be transferred to the Public Administration in the cases provided for in the legislation and for the purposes defined therein, and to the financial entities for the management of collections. Likewise, the data may be transferred to the university of origin for the correct control of the programs carried out by the student, as applicable. This transfer may involve an international transfer of data, depending on the country where the university of origin is located, which is necessary for the correct development of the academic-contractual relationship maintained with the interested party, since said university must control the programs carried out for its students.

You have the right to request access to your personal data, its rectification or deletion, as well as the limitation of its treatment, to oppose it and its portability. In case of any possible violation of your rights, you can file a claim with the Spanish Data Protection Agency.

If the personal data of a third party has been provided, it is the sole responsibility of the person who has previously obtained the consent of that person so their data is processed by NEBRIJA UNIVERSITY, and must have previously informed them of all the provisions of Article 13 of the General Data Protection Regulation.
