

ENDANGERED ANIMALS

Over 40% of species are estimated to be at risk of extinction. There are 3079 animals and 2655 plants endangered worldwide in 2014 compared to only 1102 and 1197, respectively in 1998.

SEA TURTLES

- Slaughtered for their eggs, meat, skin and shells.
- Habitat destruction.
- Accidental capture.



POLAR BEARS

- Depend on sea ice to hunt.
- Ice is decreasing in size.
- Poachers hunt them.



IBERIAN LYNX

- Diseases.
- Loss of scrubland.
- Human development.
