



## March 7th exam postponed for public health reasons

Dear students,

Surely you already know that this week both the Spanish health authorities and those of other countries are recommending that citizens avoid traveling between areas where cases of coronavirus have been detected, unless it is for essential reasons.

This recommendation and caution have led us to **postpone the examination of the students of the DEDIC and DEDID groups in the Bachelor's Degree in Law, which was to be taken on March 7<sup>th</sup> at 9 a.m. at the Madrid Princesa Campus, in Milan and other centers authorized for this purpose.**

Nebrija University has immediately contacted the competent university authorities, which in our case are those of the Community of Madrid, in order **to jointly seek a solution to this problem if the situation continues.** As soon as we have more official information, we will let you know.

The University is doing everything possible to solve this issue as soon as possible, which is derived from a problem that is out of everyone's hands and that affects society as a whole. We will also do what is necessary to **prevent it from affecting our students' educational itinerary.**

We apologize for any inconvenience this decision may have caused, but we must put the safety and health of our students and professors before any other consideration.
