



Nebrija University guarantees the right to assessment in the 2019/2020 academic year

Dear students,

The Spanish Network of University Quality Agencies has issued a statement announcing that it undertakes to recognize in its assessment processes “the changes introduced and made public by the university bodies in the development of educational programs in response to this exceptional situation.”

This means that, due to the unprecedented situation that we are experiencing, **we will be able to assess online** not only those who are enrolled in distance learning programs, but **also all those who were enrolled in class attendance degrees** and are currently studying them virtually due to the coronavirus crisis.

We will continue to carry out virtual education for all programs as long as necessary and as long as the authorities maintain the isolation of the population.

We are studying measures **that will allow subjects with fundamentally practical content to also be taken by students and assessed during the current academic year 2019/2020**. This will prevent students from having to enroll in these subjects next year if they pass the assessment. The contents that are not possible to transfer to the online modality (for example, of subjects such as Photography, Audiovisual Technology, Acrobatics, Pattern Design, Drawing, etc.) will be complemented as soon as the situation allows it, with practical modules and workshops in order to guarantee the students' expectations of knowledge, competences and learning. Given the situation, we cannot establish the timeframes in which this 100% practical knowledge can be acquired, but the students will be able to be assessed in their subjects within this academic year.

Therefore, Nebrija University guarantees the right to assessment in the 2019/2020 academic year for all students, whether they are taking class attendance, distance or blended programs. The way in which the examinations will be carried out will be communicated to the students by their Schools and programs as established in their plan.

We ask the entire community that these exceptional circumstances and the measures we are forced to take do not serve as an excuse to try to achieve academic results that are not in accordance to the real merits of each student. **We ask you for the responsibility and ethics of the university spirit** during this situation. The University will grant the necessary means to carry out the corresponding checks in each assessment in order to safeguard academic integrity.
