



Measures for the evaluation of class attendance programs, curricular internships and international mobility

Dear students,

As you know, the exceptional measures taken by the authorities to curb the contagion of COVID-19 have forced us to **rethink** the way in which **in-person education** is taught in order to continue guaranteeing the continuity of classes and the assessment of our students.

You have all **been able to continue** your classes in the **remote modality** launched by Nebrija University. The necessary decisions have also been taken to guarantee the assessment of the theoretical and practical subjects of the remote programs.

These measures, taken by Nebrija University and agreed upon and protected by the relevant educational authorities, ensure that **no student will lose the 2019-2020 academic year** due to the health crisis we are experiencing.

The **rectoral resolution** that explains in detail all the **agreed measures** can be found **here**. Below, we offer a summary of the decisions it contains:

- **Lectures.** Classes will continue to be taught in the remote modality as long as the suspension of the in-person academic activity lasts.
- **Subjects with practices.** The clinical, experimental, laboratory, etc. practical subjects that cannot be transferred to virtual mode will be **considered to have been passed for academic purposes if 60%** have been completed and **basic competences have been acquired**. If this result were not possible, they can be **resumed at the beginning of the next academic year** without having to re-enroll the subject.
- **Curricular internships.** The percentage necessary to pass them has been **established as 50% of the credits or their equivalent in hours**, according to the teaching guide. If the companies where the internships are being carried out allow it, they will be able to **continue carrying out the internships in a remote work modality**. If the internships have not started or have not exceeded 50%, they can be carried out and completed in online mode whenever possible. If there is no such possibility, the internships will be resumed when in-person activity is resumed.
- **International mobility.** These programs **may be assessed** if at least **75% of the credits or the corresponding teaching hours** have been completed. If this is not the case, the possibilities will be studied for the time when academic activity is resumed.
- **Exams.** The **exams** of all the class attendance programs are **guaranteed**, both in bachelor's and master's degrees. They will be carried out in **official calls**, both ordinary and extraordinary, **remotely** if the situation allows it, or online, while the in-person academic activity is suspended.
- The **Final Research Projects for Bachelor's and Master's Degrees** will also be adapted to the circumstances in which we find ourselves. The **presentations and defenses** will be made **remotely** or will be evaluated according to what is stated in the report after readjustment of the weighting **criteria**.

Before asking individual questions or cases to the academic departments, we ask you **to carefully read this document that explains in detail how all the academic activities included in the 2019-2020 academic year** will be assessed. We also want to transmit a message of calm from Nebrija University, which continues to take the necessary measures to guarantee your education with the excellence that characterizes us.

Thank you very much for your effort and work during this difficult situation.
