



MORE INFORMATION ON NEBRIJA'S HYBRID ATTENDANCE MODEL

Dear students,

As a continuation to the communiqué on the implementation of hybrid attendance at our University for the 20/21 academic year as an extraordinary measure, we bring you the list of subjects that require physical attendance, either regularly or in an extraordinary way, through intensive in-person workshops at the end of the academic year.

We have made the requirement of your physical presence on campus as flexible as possible; however, our commitment to academic quality and our desire to completely ensure learning results, make it necessary to require your physical presence in certain subjects. This is due to the fact that said subjects, due to their practical nature, their teaching methodologies or the need for technical means not accessible outside the University, are not suitable to be taken in remotely.

As you will see, in most of the subjects you can choose to be physically or remotely present. Compulsory physical presence is focused on some degrees of the School of Communication and Arts, in Sciences of Physical Activity and Sport, as well as to a much lesser extent, in the Higher Polytechnic School. No subject of the School of Social Sciences requires physical attendance.

We advise you to analyze your specific case in order to make the best decision regarding the possibility of opting for our hybrid attendance system with the corresponding logistical or family consequences. The request will affect complete semesters and, therefore, at the return of the summer, whoever wishes to do so, may request to study remotely during the first semester. In any case, we will keep you informed.

Likewise, those of you who have carried out self-enrollment in Nebrija for the next academic year, we recommend that if you have to make a change in your degrees, you notify the Registrar's Office through the following email address: secretaria@nebrija.es

Finally, we remind you that our campuses have all the necessary security measures to ensure the sanitary health of the university community.
